Start of Block: Athletic Fee Referendum

Nearly 300 student-athletes participate in intercollegiate athletics at UT Tyler on 18 teams. The UT Tyler Patriots compete in the NCAA Division II Lone Star Conference with the lowest student athletic fee in the conference. An increase in this fee will make other funds available for student engagement and support opportunities.

Do you support the increase of the UT Tyler athletic fee to fund athletics, increase the value of your UT Tyler degree, and provide students with more engagement and support opportunities?

The proposed fee would increase:

\$2 per semester credit hour (from \$16 to \$18) in Fall 2024 with the cap increasing to \$270;

\$2 per semester credit hour (from \$18 to \$20) in Fall 2025 with the cap increasing to \$300; and

\$2 per semester credit hour (from \$20 to \$22) in Fall 2026 with the cap increasing to \$330.

The current fee cap is \$240.
