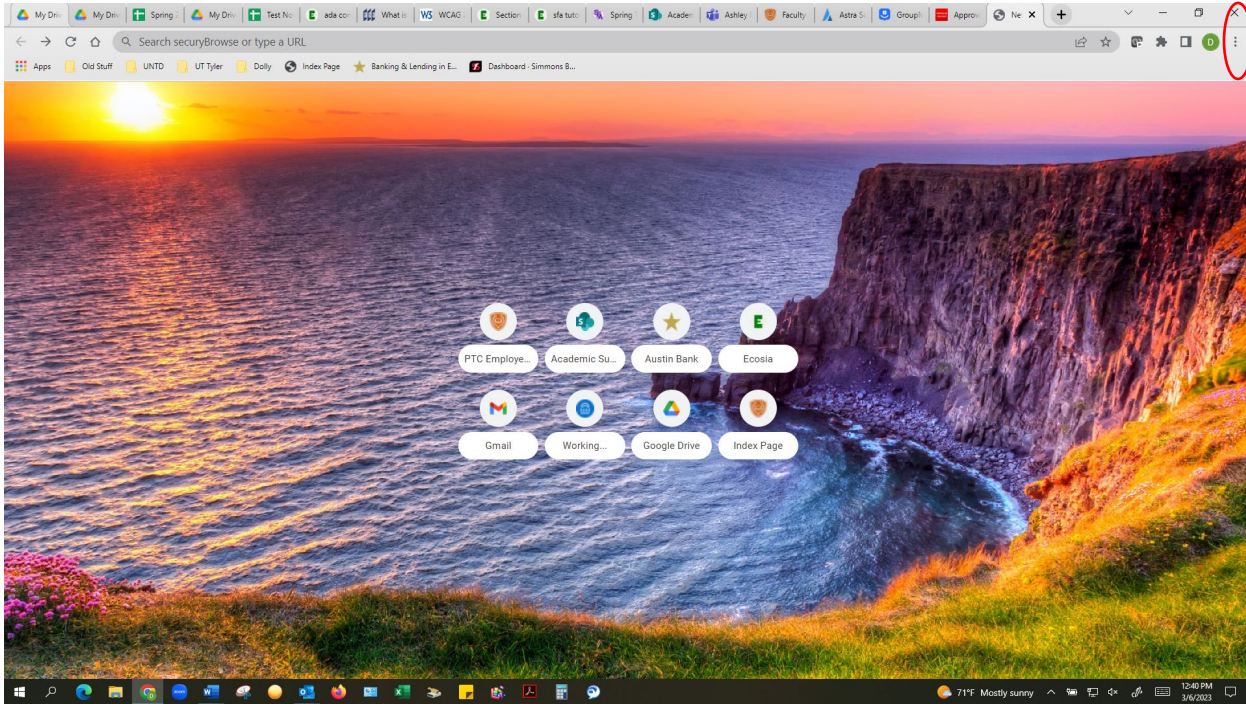
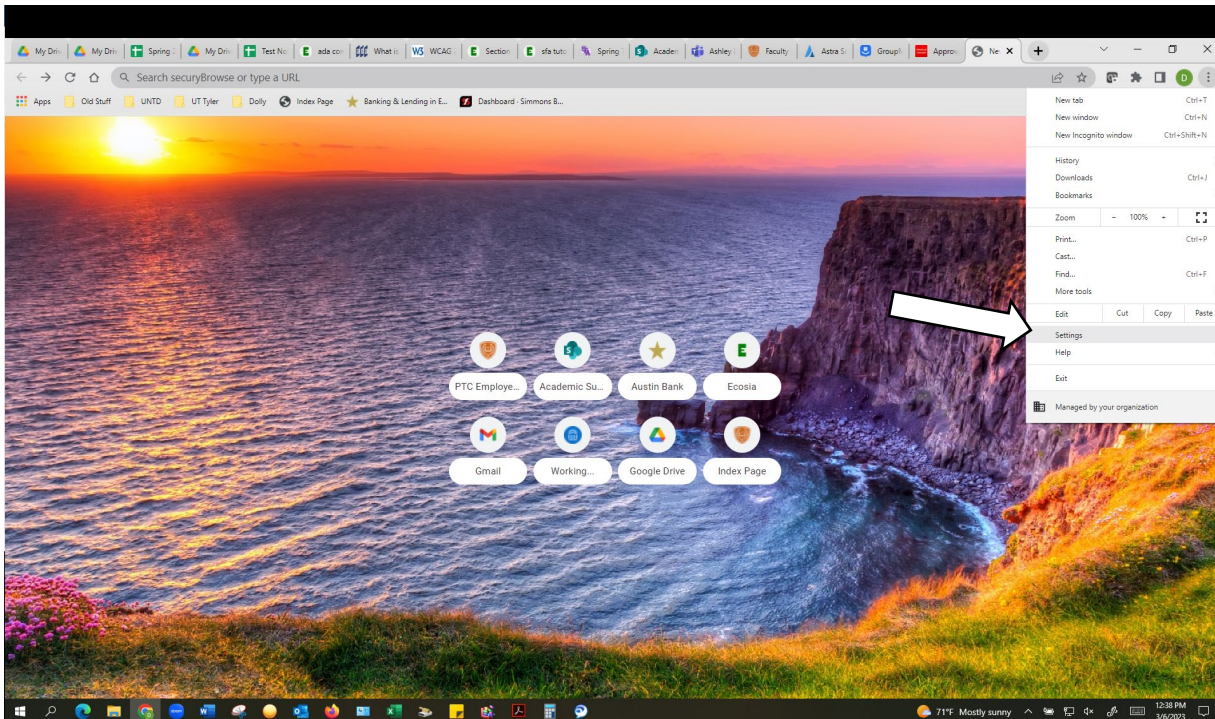


How to enable Google Chrome Live Captions

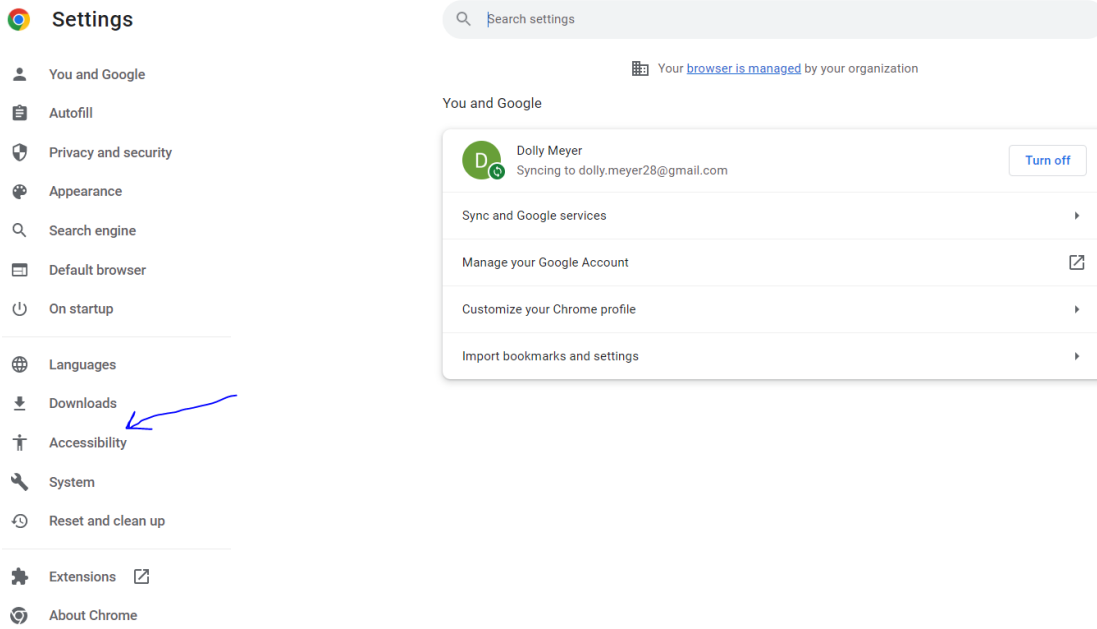
Open google chrome. Click the three dots on the far right hand side:



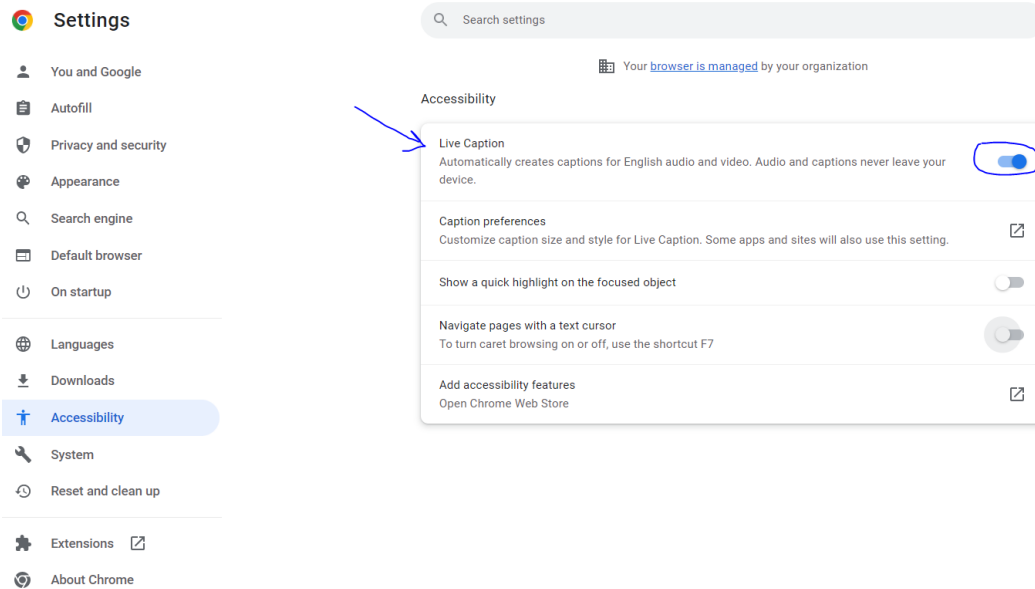
Click "settings"



Settings will open in a new tab. Click “Accessibility” on the left-hand side:



A new menu will appear. Select the toggle for “Live Captions.” When the toggle is blue, this means the option for Live Captions is activated. There are options below for caption font color and sizes. There are also more features you can select from the store if you click “Add accessibility features.”



Now that the Live Captions are enabled, live captions will automatically play whenever audio is detected from your google chrome browser. For example, live captions will automatically start when you play a video, join a video call, or meet with a tutor in Upswing.
