In accordance with the SGA Constitution Article V Section 5.21 - Amendments to the SGA Constitution shall become effective after ratification by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of students voting on said amendment in an election, after certification by the Chairman of the Rules Committee that such amendments have been duly ratified, the Chief Student Affairs Officer, the President of the University.

The following addition to the SGA Bylaws has been adopted by the Senate and is submitted for Student Body for Approval:

ARTICLE IV Communication with Student Body

I. Email

A. Because communication between SGA and the Student Body is necessary for SGA to effectively represent the interest of the Student Body, SGA hereby gives itself the authority to send emails to the Student Body of the University of Texas at Tyler

B. The following positions have the ability to send e-mails with the approval of both the SGA President and the Director of Student Engagement:

- SGA President · SGA Vice President · SGA Secretary
- SGA Treasurer/ SGAC Chair · SGA Parliamentarian · SGA Advisor

C. Emails must contain, but not limited to, one of the following categories; Health and Safety, SGA Elections, SGA Events, School Wide Events, Surveys, SGA Newsletters, Major Changes that affect all students, and Student Organization funding through SGAC.

a. The above

topics shall be sorted into distinct categories, weekly, and monthly emails.

i. Weekly emails may contain, Health and Safety, SGA Events, Surveys, SGA Elections, and Major changes that affect all students.

ii. Monthly Emails may contain, Schoolwide Events, SGA Newsletters and Student Organization Funding through SGAC D.
