Attendance

Attendance is required for a pre-recital hearing generally one month in advance, a dress rehearsal, and the scheduled performance. Due to the nature of this course, no make-up is possible for absences.

Course Requirements

Student is responsible for writing program notes to present at the recital hearing and submitting program information to the music office 2 weeks prior to the recital date. The recital performance should reflect the ability to communicate with an audience using refined technical and musical skills and an understanding of stylistic and historical periods of music.

For trumpet students, preparation and successful public performance of repertoire selections should represent a cross section of styles from Classical, Romantic, and Contemporary periods.
