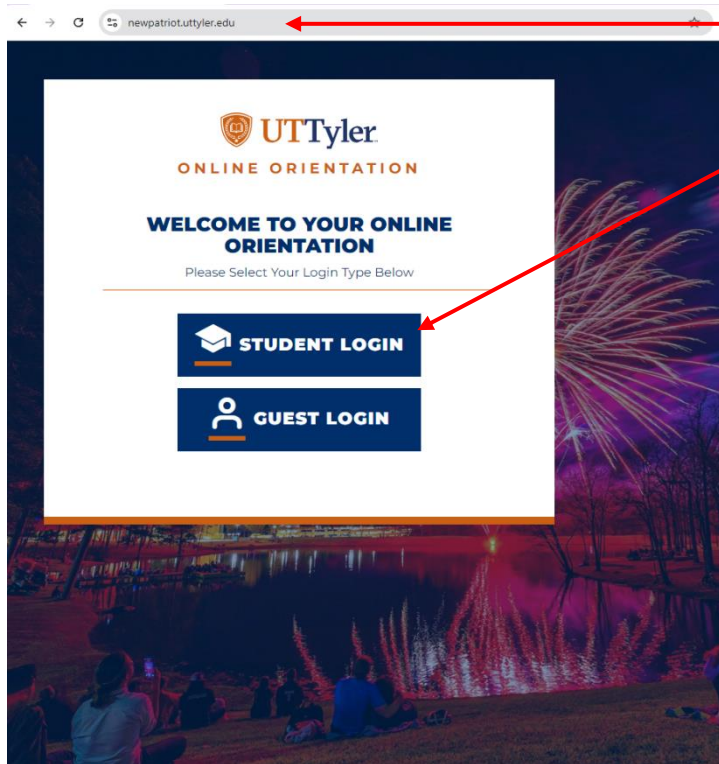
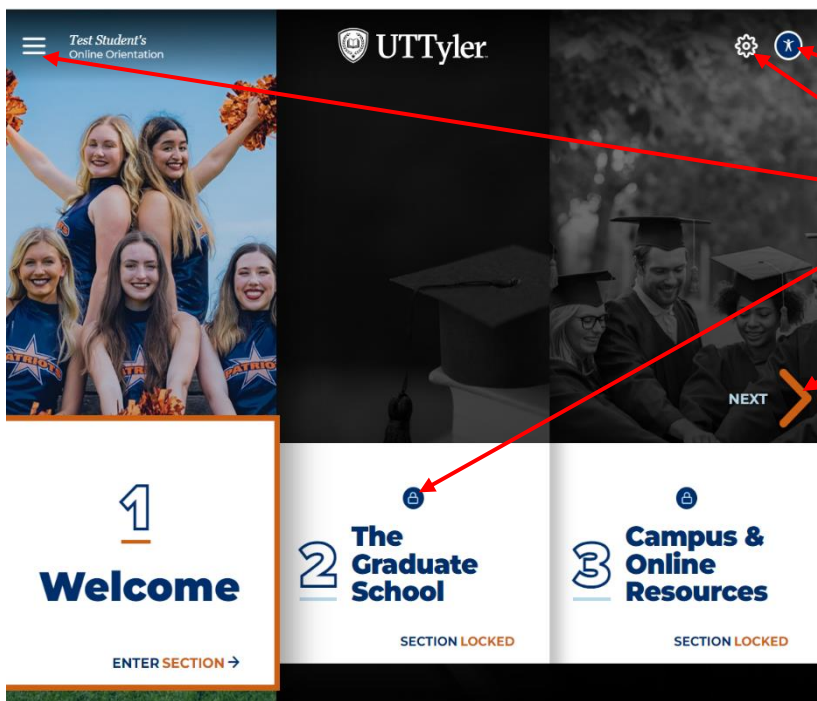


ONLINE ORIENTATION PLATFORM OVERVIEW




- This is the landing page of the online orientation platform.
- Select “**Student Login**”, and type in your UT Tyler Patriot login credentials (email and password).




This is the Homepage. Here, you can:

- Navigate across sections





The Basics

- Your online orientation is made up of sections accessible through the main menu items and the menu icon on your home screen. To begin, click the title of the module from either view.
- Each section is made up of a series of slides. To complete each section, click through the slides using the next and previous buttons.
- A section is complete when you view the last slide.
- You must complete each section in order.

When you complete this orientation, all of the sections will be unlocked and available for you to use as a reference.

Some slides include an "i" button and statement that begins with "I would like to learn more about..." If you want to save this information to review it later, click the "i" button. You'll find a link to more information about that topic on your resource page when you complete your orientation.

Glossary Terms
Be on the lookout for glossary terms! You can find a complete listing of glossary terms by pressing the Glossary button on the home screen.

Search
Here you can access the search feature. When you search for a term, you'll be presented with results based on the progress you've made so far. All search terms are released when you complete your orientation.

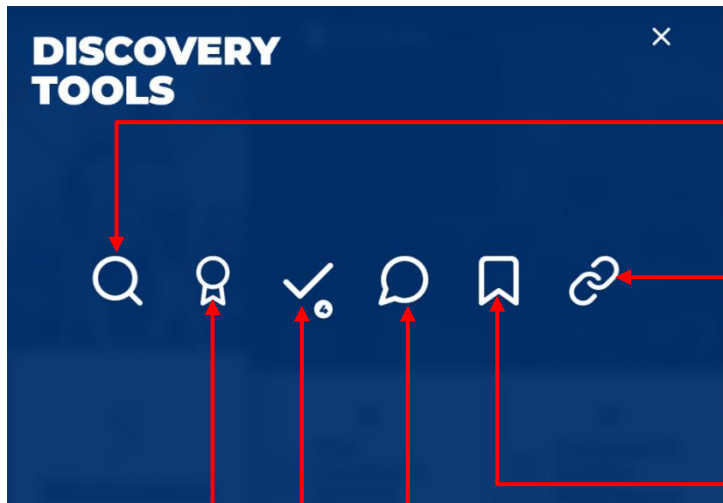
Use this guide to learn about the orientation platform and any features you may need clarity on.



Find the Home button on the top left corner of every page while navigating through the orientation. You can click on the button to go back to the homepage anytime.



This is the print button. You can print the content on whatever page you see this button on. Just click on this to create a printable PDF file of the content you need.



- The Search tool allows you search the entire orientation using words or phrases to find specific content.
- Use the Resources tool to find key resources like your items of interest that you have selected during the orientation and other helpful resources that have been linked there for you
- The Glossary tool allows you to see definitions of some terms that you come across throughout the orientation
- The FAQs tool allows you view answers to some questions other students like you have asked previously. It also allows you ask your own questions and add to the knowledge bank
- Use the Checklist & Announcements tool to view the recommended to-do items and important announcements even after you have completed your orientation
- Use the Achievements tool to see all the badges you achieve as you progress through the orientation
