HNRS 4000 is a zero-credit course that is required for participation in the Honors Program. This course is designed to allow students to get the most out of their experience in the Honors Program during their time at UT Tyler. HNRS 4000 will focus on completion of requirements for graduation. Additionally, students will be required to attend all Honors Colloquium events during the semester in which they are enrolled in the class. This course is designed to be taken twice and in sequence, beginning in the fall semester.

Student Learning Outcomes

- Students will fill out necessary paperwork for graduation.
- Students will attend Honors colloquium events.

Evaluation

Students will receive a grade of either “CR” (credit) or “NC” (no credit) for this course. Please keep in mind, as a zero-credit course, no credit hours are earned. Additionally, students must earn a satisfactory evaluation on the following assignments:

- Colloquium Attendance (Lyceum in April and other events as announced)
- Canvas Participation (turning in paperwork for contract courses, meetings for service or leadership tracks, etc.)

Students will earn a satisfactory evaluation by preparing and fully participating in the aforementioned assignments. Students who do not earn a grade of CR in an Honors Seminar will lose good standing in the Honors Program.
