Checklist: Immunizations and Documentation Requirements for UT Tyler Nursing Students

Definition of a titer: An antibody titer is a blood test that measures the number of antibodies in your blood. This determines if you have immunity to the disease. <u>Titer results must be IgG (not IgM) and include the reference range as well as your results.</u>

Note: the only vaccine that "requires" a titer is Hepatitis B (ask for the "Hepatitis B Surface Antibody" titer also called HBsAb or anti-HB). If results are negative, the two-dose Heplisav-B series is recommended. Obtaining a titer is an option for MMR and Varicella if you have lost your immunization records.

There is no time limit on how recent the vaccines must have been administered. Proof of completion of the vaccine series as a child is adequate.

1. Hepatitis B (Hep B) **Alert** This requirement can	Positive titer required. If results are negative/equivocal, additional dose(s) of vaccine required. Choose either 3-dose series Engerix-B or Recombivax HB (6 months for series) OR 2-dose series Heplisav-B (1 month apart).
take 7 months to meet. Start early!	Repeat titer 1 month after last dose. Optional: check titer 1 month after 1 st dose. See QR codes for details.
2. MMR (Measles, Mumps, & Rubella)	Two (2) doses of vaccine (at least 1 month apart) OR Positive IgG titers for all 3 components
3. Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Two (2) doses of vaccine (at least 1 month apart) <u>OR</u> positive IgG titer <u>OR</u> documented history of varicella or herpes zoster.
4. Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis)	At least 1 Tdap AND proof of tetanus containing vaccine (Tdap or Td) within the last 10 years.
5. COVID 19 (This is required by <u>all</u>	Complete CDC recommendations for 'intital dosing' (<u>1 dose</u> of Moderna/Pfizer <u>bi</u> valent, <u>OR</u> <u>1 dose</u> of Johnson
clinical facilities, not UTT specifically)	& Johnson, <u>OR 2 doses</u> of Moderna/Pfizer/Novavax <u>mono</u> valent) <u>OR</u> appropriate medical or religious
	exemption request found on the policy website. Note: no additional boosters required.
6. Influenza (Flu)	Depends on the semester you are enrolling. Flu vaccine is required 'during flu season'. See QR codes for details.
	Required annually thereafter before October 31.
7. Basic Life Support (BLS)	Must be a BLS course designed for healthcare providers. Must be issued by American Heart Association (AHA) or
