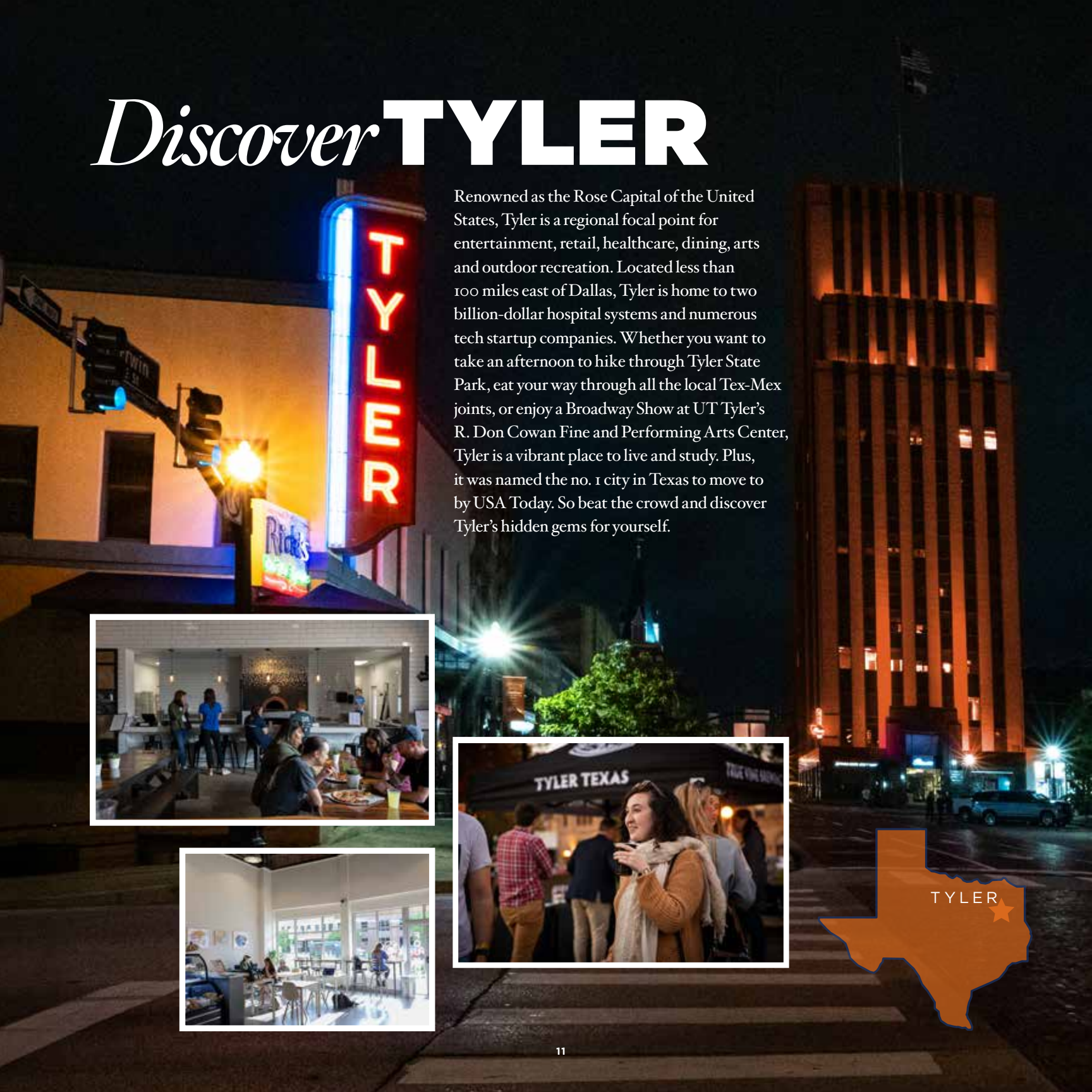

Pursue YOUR FUTURE *at the*



While each program has separate, specific admission requirements, all students apply through the following steps.

1. REVIEW OFFICIAL REQUIREMENTS

Review all general Graduate School and program admission requirements, including previous education, standardized test scores and, for international candidates, proof of English proficiency.

2. SEND TRANSCRIPTS

Send transcripts showing completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university or a recognized comparable international degree to the Office of Graduate Admissions.

3. COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

Follow all deadlines for completing and submitting your graduate admissions application. Remember to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
