- Prerequisite Coursework Complete with grade “C” or higher:** *Must complete by May 31, 2025, unless summer courses have been pre-approved by the Office of Student Affairs.*

 - Fundamentals of Speech
 - Calculus I
 - Organic Chemistry I + Lab²

 - Human Anatomy & Physiology I + Lab² (may be substituted with Human Anatomy + Lab²)
 - Human Anatomy & Physiology II + Lab² (may be substituted with Human Physiology + Lab²)
- Texas Core Curriculum Complete:** *All students (both in-state and out-of-state) who **do not** have a prior bachelor’s degree must complete the Texas Core Curriculum. You can find more information [here](#) and determine if you are Core Complete [here](#).*

 - Must have three letters of recommendation submitted on your behalf for your application to be considered complete.

¹ GPA calculations are calculated using a four-point scale and include:

- All college coursework from accredited U.S. and foreign institutions
- Dual-credit coursework
- Advanced Placement, College-Level Examination Program, and the International Baccalaureate Program (Information on Required Scores [here](#))
- Original and repeated course grades

²Courses must be completed within seven years of entering the program. If necessary, you may request an exemption to the prerequisites or other requirements by submitting an [Exemption Request Form](#).

³Many of the pharmacy pre-requisites will count towards these categories of the Texas Core Curriculum.
