- Courtney Smith over government relations meeting with elected officials discussing the upcoming legislative session; meetings have gone very well
- August Board of Regents meeting never wants what is discussed to be a surprise to anyone on campus
 - Proposal for funding for Pharmacy tuition
 - o Proposal for Oceans to discuss expansion of behavioral health
- Chief Strategy Officer is important new hire reporting directly to Dr. Philley; will be able to come to next meeting; grew up in Tyler external strategy
- Scholarship program
 - Committee began looking at how long can be financially viable in January or February
 - decision made to limit to one degree per person in an effort to touch as many lives as we can of our employees and keep the program intact while being able to sustain it
 - Feel did not do the best job getting the word out about the changes and could have done a better job
 - o not able to grandfather anyone in on the policy, but maintain consistency across the board limiting it to one degree per person
 - o work with HR on other possible sources of funding; don't give up on your dreams before letting them try to help with funding
 - o if one child but 2 faculty parents, check with HR
 - extends to Health Science Center academic employees as well; categories for Health Science Center employees are defined on the Employee Benefit website
