12:42 President Update: Dr. Calhoun

- Several construction projects ongoing: Medical school building & nursing building are in progress, design and planning for science building, UA expansion and safety enhancements,
- Childcare: working to get childcare facilities for employees; will be in UA building and will require building/safety enhancements; hoped to be able to move on that more quickly but due to regulations, it will likely take 1-2 years to get that going
- Faculty pay: ongoing conversation; looking at new benchmarks; team reviewing now to help increase salaries to recruit and maintain quality faculty
- Legislative session: UT System is highly engaged
  - Funding for higher education: hoping for increased formula funding, Dr. Calhoun has testified in support of UTT; hoping to be able to get more funding for salary increases
  - Tenure: some kind of legislation is coming (SB 18 to be voted on today), could create a timeline for tenure reviews, our goal is to make sure legislation is constructive and check the details; one potential bill to make BOR grant tenure-UT System already does that
  - DEI- SB17 already passed Senate; UTT trying to ensure that whatever ends up being the final legislation is beneficial to UTT
  - CRT-historically legislation has not dealt with higher ed; could include legislation that it be taught as a theory

12:56 Legislative Update: Dr. David Coursey- UT System FAC (Faculty Advisory Council)

- SB 18: Tenure bill-effectively eliminates tenure; planned to have a floor substitute before vote today, but just heard that won't be happening so vote will be on bill as is; however, not much traction on this issue in the House but will be watching
- SB 17: DEI-abolished DEI programs/initiatives; passed the Senate but not likely to pass the House
- SB 16: CRT-passed in Senate; can't compel a student to believe certain political positions; associated fine; highly unlikely to pass House

- All programs showed growth
- Invested \$161 K, Revenue almost \$254 K; ROI 157%
- Plan to expand for 23-24 year but does not have to include GA positions if not applicable to program
- Must admit at least 10 more students than last year
- Did market analysis to choose programs and discussed feasibility with faculty
- New programs for next academic year: cyber security, public administration, civil engineering, chemical engineering, communications, math
- FYI: endowment scholarship applications open but closes May 1; encourage students to apply
