We rely on volunteers to sort the donated food so we can feed the hungry. Repack Goods We purchase staples such as Rice, Beans, and Pasta which volunteers repack into smaller, two pound bags for families. Dry goods are probably our most popular product that we distribute, and there is always a need for more to be produced! Backpack Program and Senior Servings In East Texas, 1 in 4 children and 1 in 7 senior citizens are at-risk of hunger. To combat this, volunteers help produce easy-to-open bags of nutritious food for these individuals to take home each weekend. Backpacks are set up in a pick line, where volunteers walk by each station and place the items into their bag. Senior Box Program and Mobile Pantry Volunteers help put together boxes of food for families and seniors that are at-risk of hunger. These boxes are distributed once a month to different locations across East Texas. This is an assembly line-type project, where boxes will be pushed by volunteers on a belt, and they are responsible for placing their product in each box.
